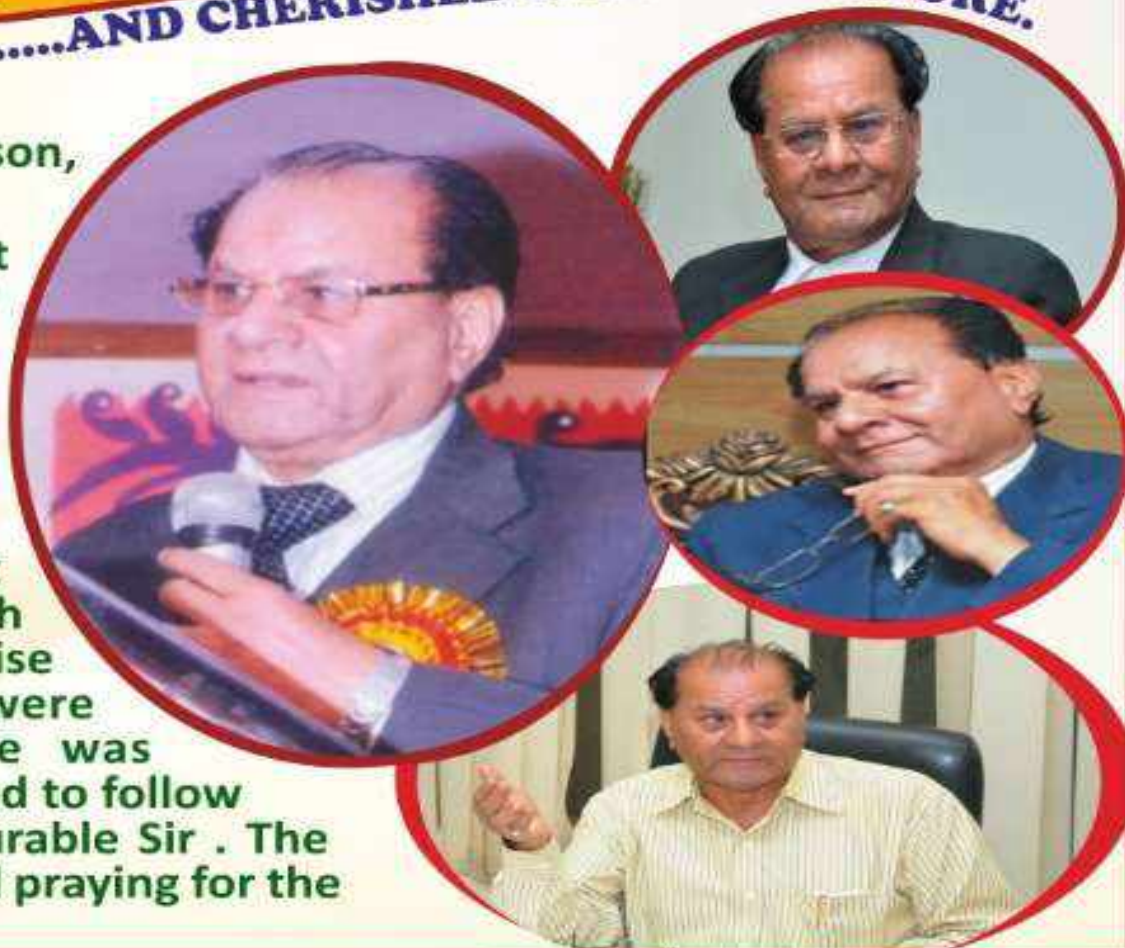

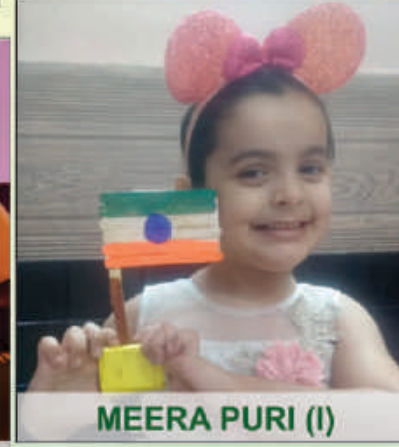
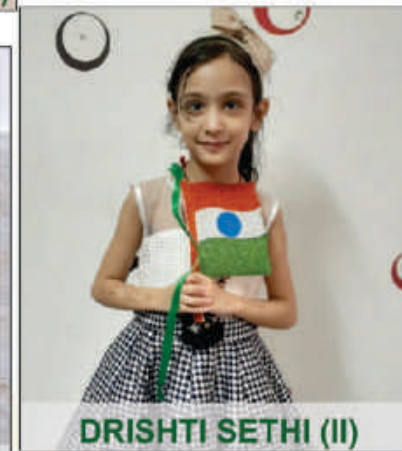

Our Country is one Pride, Our Nation is the glory. The struggle moment of our Freedom is an untold story.

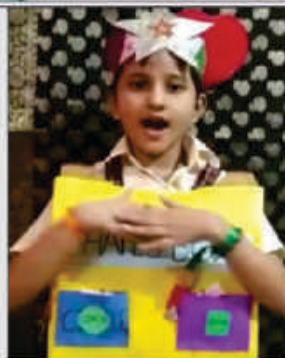

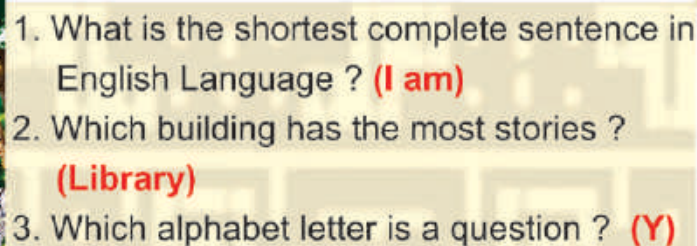
