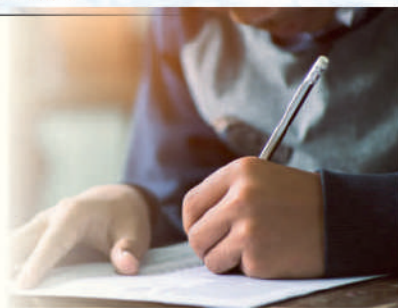

FRIENDSHIP DAY

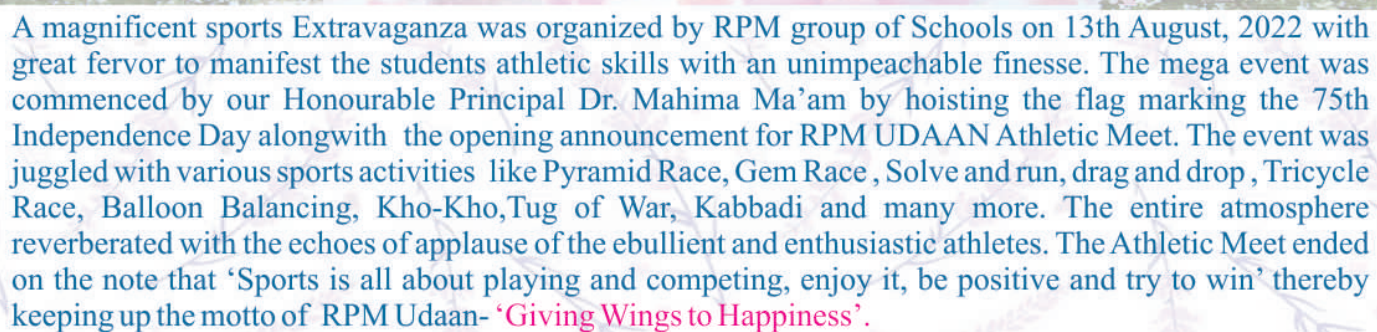
'A Friend in need is a friend indeed'

Freedom in the mind, Faith in the words, Pride in our souls

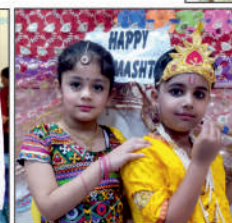
