**Science is a way of thinking much more than it is a body of knowledge**

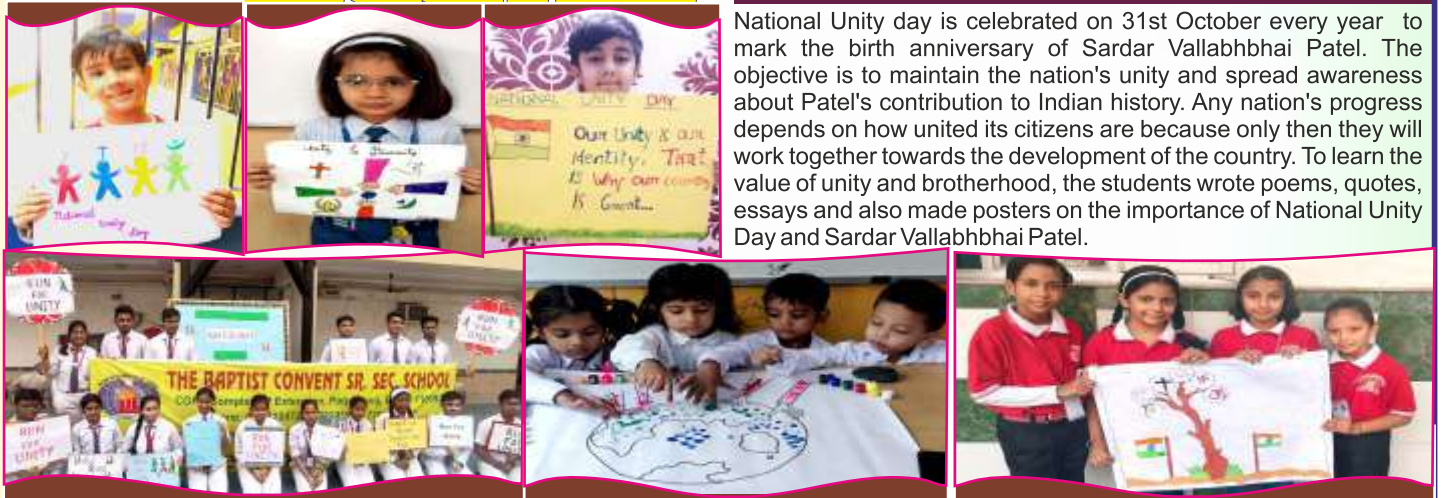
